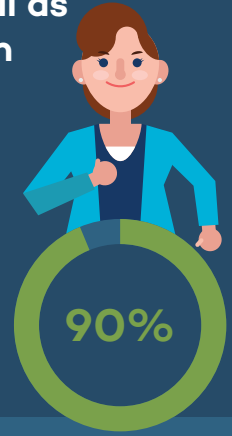

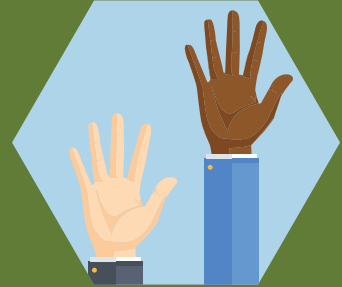
Health & wellbeing

We pledge to reduce the demand for crisis interventions by supporting local people experiencing substance misuse issues to improve their physical and mental health



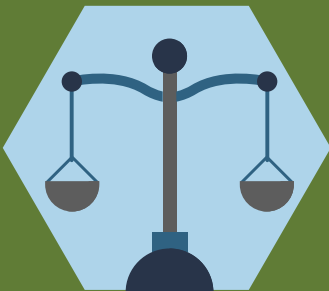
Education & skills
